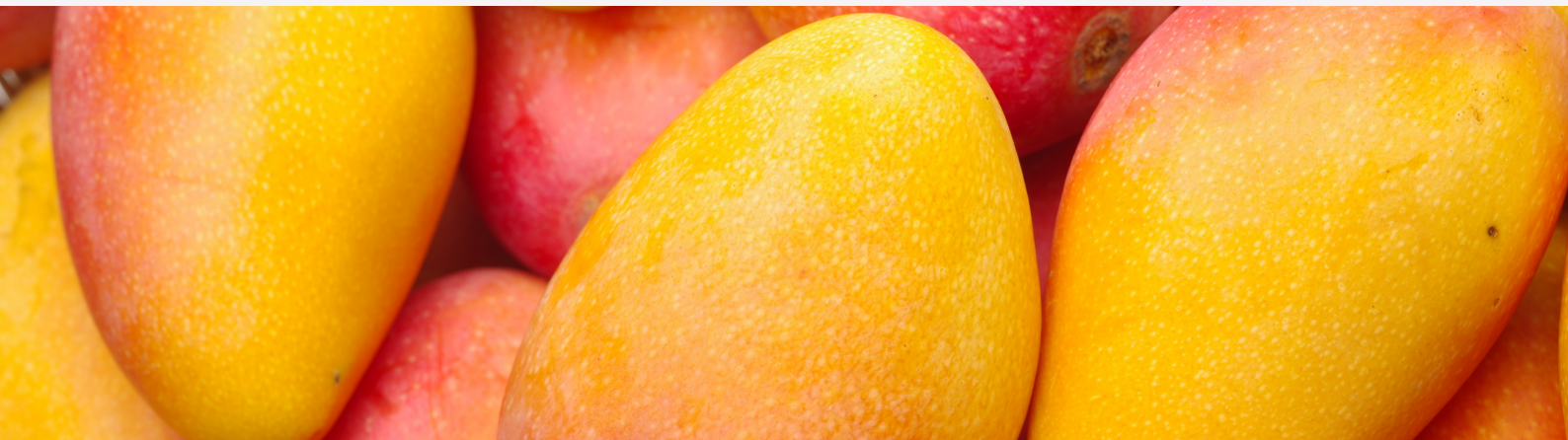

OUR IMPACT

BTPA are a team of volunteers who believe that we can make a change. We work closely with Bahay Tuluyan to identify needs and respond accordingly.

In recent years, we have helped:

- Provide food relief packages for people affected by the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Purchase a vehicle so the staff can visit the children on the streets;
- Fund 1000 years of education, breaking the cycle of poverty; and
- Invest in Nature Farms, which grow organic food to feed the children and teach young adults critical skills.
