KIDSVIEW CONFERENCES

KidsView is a full day incursion / conference designed to create awareness of global issues, with a particular focus on poverty and injustice. Bahay Tuluyan's Director, Catherine Scerri, is an Australian who has worked in the Philippines for 21 years. Two youth ambassadors from the Philippines will accompany Catherine. They will share their own stories to help students connect on a personal level.

Topics covered include the social issues surrounding education, health, home and work. Through hands-on workshops, the students will explore these topics through adopting a new identity for the day.

During an incursion, the KidsView team will work with up to 100 students for a full day. Incursions are suitable for Years 5 - 10.

Conferences are suitable for Year 5/6 students. Schools can send up to 15 students to a full day interschool conference. This is a great opportunity for Social Justice groups, school leaders or interested students.
